A Review of Dr. Herrstrom's Messages

The Bottom Line – Facing fear God's way is believing that God is indeed all powerful, all knowing, all loving, sovereign, and good, and therefore I will trust him with anything and everything, regardless of the present look of things.

"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand." (Is. 41:10)

"If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to save us from it, and he will rescue us from your hand, O king. But even if he does not, we want you to know, O king, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up." (Dan. 3:18-19)

"Some men came and told Jehoshaphat, 'A vast army is coming against you from Edom'...Alarmed (terrified), Jehoshaphat (prayed)... we have no power to face this vast army that is attacking us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are upon you... This is what the Lord says to you: 'Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God's. Tomorrow march down against them...Take up your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will give you, O Judah and Jerusalem. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the Lord will be with you.'" (2 Chronicles 20:1-17)

Natural Emotion - fear

Natural Emotional Response - fight, flight, freeze

Mental Interpretation- the emotional response is filtered through established beliefs, values, and experiences to making sense of the response

Feelings Assigned -a connection is established between emotion and thought

Replay and Review – an evaluation of emotional response, mental interpretations, assigned feelings, resulting behaviors, experiences, and consequences

Accept/ Reject/ Revise/ Ignore – a decision is made in preparation for when something similar happens in the future

Default Setting Established/Modified/ Reinforced/ Strongholds DevelopThe connection between emotions, thoughts, feelings, and behaviors becomes more deaply on translated and gains a payor to influence our responses conserving futures.

deeply entrenched and gains power to influence our responses concerning future events; I now have a learned, conditioned future action plan for future emotional responses

Something Happens, and the process repeats

Natural vs. Supernatural Responses

"The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned." (1 Cor. 2:14)

"Faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ." (Romans 10:17)

"Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see. This is what the ancients were commended for. By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible. By faith..." (Heb. 11:1-40)

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" (2 Cor. 5:17)

Natural Response – Fight, Flight, or Freeze – automatic, unconscious response

Supernatural Response – Faith – learned, conscious, intentional response

Natural vs. Supernatural Actions

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." (Heb. 12:1-2)

"...so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.
